Die Zahlungsanweisungen wurden ausgestellt für Sold, Uniformen, Waffen, zur Unterstützung von Soldatenfamilien, für Aufwendungen von Ärzten, Repräsentanten und vieles mehr. Einige Zertifikate tragen zudem die Unterschriften berühmter Persönlichkeiten. Ein Papier wurde beispielsweise von Jedediah Huntington signiert.
